

ASTROLOGY for beginners

For COMPLETE beginners we have put together a Starter Pack comprising:-

A simple program to calculate a horoscope

A 12 page introductory booklet explaining how astrology works 2 self-teaching programs (how to interpret the horoscope)

The AØ calculation program (available separately for £8) gives the natal positions of the planets, Ascendant and Midheaven with sufficient accuracy for natal interpretation (1 min inner planets, about 3 min on average outer). However, it cannot be used for more sophisticated applications such as transits, harmonics, etc.

The program calculates the major aspects (conjunctions to sextile) showing the actual orb to the nearest degree using standards described on page 20. 2 letter abbreviations are used for planets, signs and aspects in all cases (including Spectrum and Oric). Equal House positions are also shown - Koch in the German language versions.

The 2 Astrotutor programs are Planets and Signs. See page 15 for further details.

Please note the following

The AØ calculation program cannot be added to in the same way as other programs. However, it can be updated to the A1 program. Please send your copy back to us (plus £10) and we will exchange it for the A1 plus user instructions. You can, of course, add to the A1 at the same time as updating from the AØ to the A1.

Dutch and German language versions are available for Spectrum, Commodore and IBM.

For more advanced students we would recommend the A3 (natal, progressions, transits, direct chart synastry) plus the 5 Astrotutor I programs. Once reasonable mastery of the Astrotutor I is attained then Astrotutor III is highly recommended for further study in the art of synthesis and interpretation.

- * Only the Starter Packs are available for these computers.
- + Programs for the IBM and compatibles (eg the Amstrad 1512/1640) are compiled and therefore very fast. The Amstrad 8256/8512 is not an IBM compatible although we have used the same letter for the programs. Programs for these and other similar 8 and 16 bit machines the programs are normally written in MBASIC, GWBASIC or variants of these languages and the program specification may therefore differ slightly from the IBM.

Certain computers come with memory sizes other than those shown above. In these cases please ask about program availability. The normal minimum requirement for astrology is 16K of available RAM and a BASIC which can manage real numbers. Thus the unexpanded VIC2Ø, the Apple with integer BASIC, the 16K Tandy Color with normal Color BASIC, and the 16K Spectrum are NOT suitable. The 32K tape-based BBC B and the Amstrad 464 are also limited in memory when it comes to the larger programs - please enquire for exact details. However, the A1Ø and LARGER programs are now available for these machines on disc.

The new Amstrad 9512 may run our programs. However, you will NOT be able to print out with the daisy wheel printer supplied since it cannot handle the astrological symbols.

SPRED

All computers are fast compared with human beings, but some computers are faster than others. Approximate times to calculate the natal chart and 12 months transits are shown below.

We have an A1 (£15) for all of these, but because of memory constraints error checking is usually restricted to the date, and items such as qualities and elements, house positions, applying aspects, etc. are not shown. With the VIC only ONE house system is available but it can be any of the 8. With the 16K ZX81 there is also an A2 (£25), A2A (£25 - as A2 with Solar Arc Directions instead of day-for-year progressions) and an A3A (as A2A plus day-for-a-year progressions £30). These give the same basic information as described earlier but certain items - progressed declinations, etc - are omitted.

SPECTRUM PRINTER INTERFACES

It is possible to connect up the Spectrum to printers such as Epson, Seikosha, etc. To do this you need a printer 'interface program'. The latter comes in 2 forms and many variations. One form is where the program which enables you to use the printer is on a cassette; the other is where this program is in a EPROM. The difference between the 2 is usually - but not always - that the cassette versions take up additional memory whereas the EPROM versions don't. Either way your Astrocalc program may have to be amended in order to work the printer. Please give full details. Typewriter-style printers (but not daisy-wheels) will work with our Spectrum programs provided that they support the COPY command.

The Spectrum sample printouts shown later were produced using the Euroelectronics ZX LPRINT III interface and an Epson printer.

The Spectrum 128K will only work with our programs in the 48K mode so that the serial printers which work only in 128K mode will not produce a screen dump.

THE A1 (NATAL CHART) PROGRAM - £18

This program is designed for ease of use and sufficient accuracy (average error about .3 min of longitude) for the period from about 1850 to 2000. All you have to do is to input the time, date, latitude and longitude and the program will calculate the Ascendant, Midheaven, Vertex, Part of Fortune, Mean and True Nodes, plus the longitude and declinations of the planets. Equal, Placidus and Koch House systems are all included and the house positions are shown, as are the qualities and elements. Aspects may be calculated using standard aspects and orbs (see page 20), the actual orb also being shown. Applying/separating aspects between planets are indicated on most computers. All information is normally screen-based and may be printed if you have a printer.

On the disc-based Amstrads (464/6128/8256/8512), IBM and compatibles a square screen chart is included. In addition the IBM programs include a 'CLOCK' facility which is extremely useful for rectification, etc.

Symbols are clearly shown on the Spectrum and Amstrad 8256/8512 computers and can be printed on the printers. However, although symbols can probably be shown on the new Amstrad 9512 computer, the daisy wheel printer will NOT let you print these out!

THE JULIAN/GREGORIAN DATE VERSION OF THE NATAL MODULE - £22.50

This is a version of the Al program which extends the accuracy of the calculations so that 1 minute accuracy is possible for the inner planets going back to pre-Christian times, and about 1 degree accuracy for the outer planets. In addition it is possible to input dates using the Julian Calendar and the program will automatically correct for the difference between that and the Gregorian Calendar.

NATAL PROGRAM VERSION 7

New planetary routines are being developed for us which will effectively give 1 minute accuracy over at least 5000 years. This version will replace the Julian version and will gradually become available for machines such as the IBM and compatibles, all the Amstrads, BBC, Commodore, Spectrum, Tandy, etc. However, it is very unlikely that these will be introduced into the less popular machines such as the Dragon, Oric, Tandy Color and Sharp MZ ranges.

In addition, on disc-based machines many minor modifications are being made to the program to enable the user to alter certain parameters to suit his particular way of working. Thus you can specify which house system is used as standard, the orbs and aspects used in natal chart work, synastry, harmonics, etc. These questions are then no longer put to you in the main program, though you can still alter the parameters from within the program for most things.

ADDITIONAL MODULES

Unless otherwise stated, all other calculation modules depend on the A1 natal program (or Julian version) and will not work without it. Once you have the natal program it is possible to build up a program consisting of those particular techniques that you use - up to the limit of the memory of your computer. These additions will normally be supplied to you as a single program containing what you already have plus your new requirements. The cost of this update service is £5 plus the cost of the new modules. Any additions or improvements to modules will automatically be included. A similar update is offered if you change computers: ie we will exchange your existing program on your old computer for a similar one on the new for a fee of £5 plus disc.

To give you some idea of what is possible on various computers, we have produced a standard range of programs, the A1 to A10 comprising some of the more popular groupings of modules. These are listed on page 8. LARGER program combinations containing additions such as the all-progression, all-harmonics and the very powerful all-transits modules (where available) are possible on disc-based computers such as the BBC, Commodore, Tandy, Amstrad, Apricot, IBM, etc - see bottom of page 7.

The availability of programs for particular computers is indicated by a letter after the program/ module. This is the situation as at October 1987. If a particular module does not appear to be available for your computer please enquire before ordering.

Programs containing all available calculation routines, wheels, auto-gaz or UK Gaz and UK summertime and Ephemeris print where applicable for the disc-based BBC, All Amstrads, IBM and compatibles will cost between £120 and £130. CALCULATION MODULES

This is a list of the various modules currently available - these INCLUDE those which go to make up the A1 to A10 range previously described. This list is NOT exhaustive and further modules are continually being added. Where a module is not listed here but exists in a combination (eg day-for-a-year progressions for the Oric), it is because it is currently only available in the combinations shown.

The perpetual Noon/Midnight date option and method of calculating progressions (Solar Arc added to the MC), as used by the Faculty of Astrological Studies, is also now included whereever possible in addition to the standard Day-for-a-year method.

TRANS ITS

Choose any start date and the program will give you the exact date when a transit takes place. This can be either on a monthly basis for the planets Mars to Pluto, or on a daily basis for all planets.

Major aspects (cnj to sxt), except for monthly Mars transits (conjunction and opposition only). These are now date-sorted for B, C, H, I, T, E and the period of 1 degree influence is shown in days whereever this exceeds 2 days.

Gives the times and dates of eclipses, full and new moons; also aspects to natal and progressed charts.

Gives the positions of Chiron and the 4 main asteroids Ceres, Pallas, Juno and Vesta. No aspects. Isis/Transpluto and the hypothetical Transneptunian planets can be added if there is sufficient room (£8).

£5 British Summertime Correction BCDHISTEMO

Enables the input of the given time of birth. The program automatically corrects for summertime or double summertime. Disc versions include a facility to update the data file each year.

£5 UK Gazetteer

BCDHSTEMO

Contains latitudes and longitudes of from 135 to 150 of the most populous towns. Simply input the name of the town and the program gives you the coordinates.

£5 Autogaz (disc only)

CHIT

Build up your own file of towns and their positions. You are not restricted to the UK and are limited only by the size of the disc. The initial files normally contain from 300-1800 towns. You can sort, print and merge to create new files, even your own printed gazetteer!

HOUSE SYSTEMS

The standard house systems offered by the basic module are Equal, Placidus and Koch. Others offered are: Topocentric, Campanus, Regiomontanus, Alcabitus, Porphyry.

Gives the ability to work on any chart in the tropical zodiac and a sidereal zodiac. Switch from one to the other by pressing one key.

This is now included as standard in IBM programs and will be included in version 7 whereever memory space permits.

PRINTER CHART WHEELS (see page 21)

These are capable of showing up to 5 planets in a house and being used for any charts and any house system. They are NOT

automatically included in the A1 to A10 range of programs.

£7 Spectrum Printer Chart Wheel

Can show up to 5 planets in a house using the correct astrological symbols. Gives positions and cusps to the nearest degree.

- £7 2 letter Printer Chart Wheel BCDEHIT
- 2 letter abbreviations are given for the planets and signs.
- £7 Printer Chart Wheel with symbols B C I T

For the Epson FX80 (NOT RX or LX), Amstrad DMP 3000/4000, Kaga/Cannon and other code compatible dot-matrix printers where its possible to DOWNLOAD an alternative printer character set (NOT Amstrad DMP 2000/8256/8512 printer). For IBM the Wheel module offers both 2 letter and symbols options. This will be extended to other computers.

£55 4 Colour Plotter Wheel C H I

This works on a plotter-printer NOT a dot matrix printer. Prints very beautiful, neat chart wheels using 4 different colours. All symbols are clearly shown, as are the aspects lines (see front page). Like our other wheels, these can be produced for any chart which the program is capable of calculating. Also shown (not in illustration) are the calculated positions and an aspect grid. Not yet available for the Amstrad 8258/8512 (end 1987?).

The price of the plotters varies according to which make you purchase. The Sharp Plotter, which is one of the most reliable, currently costs around £230.

Chart Storage and Filing System C H I

Provided free with the specified disc-based computers. Chart information stored includes the name, time, date, latitude and longitude and house system used.

£11.50 File Service Program C H I

For viewing and manipulation of the charts stored using the Chart Storage and Filing System.

Provision for more sophisticated storage systems are also being built into the programs. There is likely to be both an external format for data transfer between computers along the lines of the ISDF standards agreed between software houses at the Ammerdown and Nottingham conferences and a variety of internal formats for different kinds of research. The first kind of internal format is likely to a relatively simple ASCII file suitable for feeding in to external databases, spreadsheets, etc., for further manipulation. Other formats will be developed, together with some of the supporting statistical and other programs that are needed. Further details will be published in astrological publications as they become

FURTHER NOTES

The Part of Fortune and sidereal time are shown on most computers except where memory is short. Quintiles and latitudes are also usually shown.

On most disc-based computers the programs are being amended to allow the creation of a configuration file containing the system standards that you use. Thus the house system, aspects, orbs, etc., can be set up to suit your way of working - within certain limitations.

PLEASE NOTE THAT SINCE WE MAKE UP MANY PROGRAMS TO ORDER, YOU MAY HAVE MORE OPTIONS SHOWN THAN ARE PRESENT IN YOUR PROGRAM. THUS SPECTRUM PROGRAMS ALWAYS GIVE A MENU SHOWING WHEEL AND MINOR PLANETS, IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER YOU HAVE ORDERED THEM.

OTHER PROGRAMS

£12.50 Midpoint Trees

H I (C?)

Disc and printer only
calculation program which will print out midpoint trees, sorted midpoints. Also gives cardinal, fixed, mutable sort and an aspectarian. As taught by the Faculty of Astrological Studies. This is NOT a standalone program and depends on the Al routine.

£4/£5 Remark Sorter

BCHISTE

Aids the writing of interpretations by accepting a large number of textual comments. These are then sorted into named categories and into the order required within each category. Very flexible but needs a printer. The disc version (£5) includes the facility to save the notes to disc (currently for H I T only).

£5 *I CHING*

BHIT

This uses the ancient Chinese method of divination which clarifies problems and helps decision-making; made simple by the computer. Gives the hexagrams plus brief interpretations selected from nearly 450 sentences stored in memory - with full on-screen instructions for use (not BBC).

£5 Biorhythms

HIST

The Spectrum version produces the normal curves on the screen. In addition it has an interesting compatibility sections. Input the name and birth-date of one person and then enter the details of up to 14 other people at one time. The computer quickly calculates the mental, emotional and physical compatibility between the first person and all the 'partners'. The other version for Tandy, Apricot, IBM, Amstrad, etc., is printer only and does not include the compatibility section.

An intriguing Adventure game based on astrology. Explore the signs and houses looking for hidden prizes. Few have won the crown!

Handwriting Analyser

This is a very powerful program which leads you through 80 different points connected with the writing and gives a trait-word interpretation based on the answers you have input. Comes complete with full instructions, including a beginner's guide to Graphology.

£16 Graphic Progressions Amstrad 8256/8512 ONLY

A novel way of showing Progressions conveniently. The program produces a large printed graph showing the actual movements of the planets and Angles as lines which cross to produce mutual aspects and aspects to natal chart. You can choose normal aspects or use any harmonic up to 60 for an in-depth examination. Up to 50 years progressions can be produced at a time (starting and ending at any age), giving a bird's-eye view of life-trends.

£16 Graphic Transits Amstrad 8256/8512 ONLY

Produces Transits in Graphical form similar to Graphic Progressions for any one complete year (see page 23).

The cost of the combined Graphic Progressions and Transits programs on the same disc is $\pounds 24$.

£11.50 Ephemeris print

HIT

This useful new program enables you to create your own Ephemeris showing the sidereal time and the planetary positions for the Sun to Pluto plus the Nodes. You can create both a midnight and noon ephemeris, in Ephemeris or Greenwich Mean Time, in the Tropical or Draconic Zodiac currently from 1890 to 2000. The printout will show either 2 letters or symbols, depending upon the capability of your printer.

When version 7 of the natal routines has been developed the restriction on date will be lifted thus giving you the opportunity to print out information for remote historical periods. In addition you will be able to create Sidereal versions.

£30 Hindu Astrology

The program calculates the planetary positions according to the ancient Vedic system of astrology and gives such details as the Major Periods, Sub-Periods, Shadvargas, etc. Transits and Planetary strengths are also calculated and there is a 20 page booklet on Hindu/Vedic astrology specially written for Western Astrologers who may want to discover more about this subject.

£5 Mail Merge & Duplicate (Amstrad 8256/8512 only)

Nothing to do with astrology; not even a program, but a very useful

booklet for users of Locoscript which gives detailed examples showing how to merge and produce multiple copies using Locoscript.

FREE! A HARMONICS TUTORIAL PROGRAM

DISC only. Currently for the Amstrad 664/6128/8256/8512 and IBM. Calculates harmonic charts and comes with a 16 page manual which teaches you what Harmonics are, their meanings, how to calculate their strength, etc. Relates directly to the new Harmonics Chart Analysis module (page 9).

FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS

Many new developments are taking place and details of some are given below.

Progressions: - The One Degree Progressions routine is being replaced by Arc Directions. This works in a similar fashion except that you can put your own Arc in, be it one degree or whatever.

Tertiaries are also in the process of being put into the Progressions routines.

Huber programs: - There are various possibilities being explored for Huber-type programs (with the approval of Huber!), but it is too early to say yet when these will be ready.

Screen Wheels: - We hope to have these for the BBC, Amstrad 8256/8512 and IBM computers some time in 1987.

Plotter Routines: - There are various other PLOTTER routines such as biorhythms and Astrology of the I-Ching. These are available for the IBM, Commodore 64 and Amstrad computers. For further details please enquire.

Batch Input: - Routines which allow to specify what you wish to do with a series of charts before any processing takes place are due to be introduced shortly on the IBM and other suitable disc computers.

Negotiations are in progress with Astrolabe (Robert Hand & Co) whereby we may be able to sell certain of their programs in this country, notably for computers we are currently not able to fully support.

PORTABLE POCKET COMPUTER

Sharp now sell a 1403 pocket computer with nearly twice as much memory as the 1401 which we used to sell. The 1403 is the same size as the 1401, measuring less than 7 inches by 3 by 1/2, and runs on two 3 volt batteries or by mains adaptor. The current price of the 1403 is £70, the mains adaptor is £9. It can be connected to a printer/cassette interface costing £50 and measuring a mere $4.5 \times 5.5 \times 1$ ins. (Unfortunately this printer is virtually unobtainable in this country at present). Can be powered by four 1.5 volt batteries or from the

mains and uses 2.3 ins wide thermal paper. The rolls of paper cost £4 for five. Postage for the computer is £3 extra. Prices for the two programs shown below are approximate only due to currency fluctuations and changes in specification. For more details please enquire.

Program 211-E Sun to Pluto, Placidus and Koch and aspects with fixed orbs (8 and 2 degrees) for the major and minor aspects. (about £28)

Program X-250-E is the most complete program for the 1403 and gives Sun to Pluto, Chiron, Isis, Placidus and Koch, Progressed charts, Transits, Midpoints, Synastry aspects, Composite charts, relations charts, Solar return time. This is about £80.

The accuracy of the positions for Sun to Mars natal longitudes is about 1 min, Jupiter to Pluto with 3-4 min on average. The planetary calculations take about 4 minutes and are displayed one at a time on the 1 line display. When the printer is connected the information is automatically printed out and the computer goes on to the next calculation.

Also available is a program giving the natal positions for Sun to Pluto as described above, Koch houses and dates according to Tad Mann's Life-Time Astrology. This costs £35.

A separate program first enables the astrologer to build up a file of his own meanings for planets in signs, planets in houses, and the various aspects. This is then linked to the natal chart or other module so that these interpretations can be printed out as required for each chart. However, there is no weighting of the strength of planets, aspects, etc.

Version 2 of this program has been much extended and improved so that it is possible to direct the output to printer and/or disc, and the length of interpretations is limited only by the disc capacity. A useful aid to proper interpretation.

STARWORD

A computer program to interpret a natal chart

Starword is a unique computer program which accepts normal birthdata and 2 to 40 minutes later (depending upon your configuration) has finished printing out on paper a complete interpretation of the birthchart, running to about 5 pages of concise, but grammatically correct delineation, set out under logical headings such as Mentality, Career, Personal Relationships, and so on. It is unique because, unlike other computer programs which print out prepared paragraphs or phrases for each chart factor, regardless of the strength of that factor, Starword first analyses and measures the factor. Thus whereas most programs will always give you a meaning for a very wide Sun square Saturn, Starword will first assess the strength of that aspect and may discard it altogether if it is too weak to be of any significance. This evaluation is done for every planet and every aspect, and so on.

When all relevant chart sources have been evaluated, Starword performs its own synthesis and makes final judgements on over 600 traits, selecting verbal output from 11 different levels for each trait or trait-pair of opposites.

Finished output is pleasingly laid out, paginated, and suitable for delivery to clients.

The above is merely the first section of a Chartmaster printout using the System 0 and Trait file 0 that are supplied with the program. There are, in fact, about 350 different trait pairs in Trait file 0 and the program operates in detecting 9 different levels from one extreme to the other. But it must be stressed that the Trait file 0 is simply the one that is supplied with the program and you are free to create any number of other Trait files, each one containing whatever information you wish. Most traits will be pairs of opposites but you can also create lists of alternatives (e.g. in choice of career).

.

However, as the output can be to disc, further editing can take place using a word processor. You can therefore build up a library of client information and detailed reports.

Because of the nature of Chartmaster, it is possible to translate the output into other languages (this can also be done with the Handwriting Analysis and Forecaster programs). Such translation is not possible with Starword.

Standards and Symbols

With the Amstrad 8256/8512 and the Spectrum the correct astrological symbols can be shown on the screen and printed. The same is true for the ORIC, except that when printing the symbols are translated back to the 2 letter abbreviations shown below. With other computers we normally use 2 letters for the planets and signs, but various graphics symbols are used to depict the aspects.





HOW TO ORDER

Apart from the Apple II, CP/M and MSDOS computers, programs are normally supplied on cassette; but disc/micro-drive versions can be supplied for the Amstrad, BBC, Commodore, Tandy TRS80/Genie and Spectrum computers. These are £4.00 extra for the 3 inch Amstrad and 3.5 inch Apricot and Spectrum, £2 for the Spectrum microdrives and the other 5.25 inch disc formats.

Most program combinations (eg all Amstrad programs plus the Astrotutor programs) will go onto 1 disc. For Chartmaster and Graphic Progressions, which are disc only, the disc is included in the price. BBC discs are 40 or 80 track single-sided, single density. Tandy/Genie, CP/M and MSDOS can be almost any single sided 5.25 inch disc format. Backup copies can be provided for £5 on cassette, or £5 + disc fee. If purchased at a later date the backup will normally contain any improvements.

No postage if GB or Kire. Overseas customers should add £5 if unable to pay in sterling and £1.00 for Postage in Kurope, £3 for other areas. Please add £1.00 if registered delivery required, \underline{ox} . £1.50 for express (but please \underline{not} both)

Payment by Access, Visa or with order either by cheque to C 8 Miles (Barclays Bank account no 50663263) or by Giro to account number 366229805 (C S Miles). Write, describing programs or modules required and naming your computer exactly; also model of printer if any.

Where you are adding to an existing program, the cost is the price of the new modules plus a £5 updating fee. Thus if you have the A1 program (£18), and decide you would now like the A2 (£33), the price is £20 (£33 - £18 + the £5 update). Any improvements/corrections/amendments will automatically be done to your existing program, so it is not normally necessary for you to send your old program back. However, we reserve the right to ask you to do this and in some cases, where individual amendments have been made, it assists us greatly if you do send the old program back. Changing computers is treated as an update - see Additional Modules page 6.

Orders are normally sent out within a few days but PLEASE ALLOW 2 WHEKS FOR DELIVERY, or more if specific alterations are being carried out for you. We will be closed for holidays from about the 20th July to the 1th August and the 23rd December to the 4th January.
