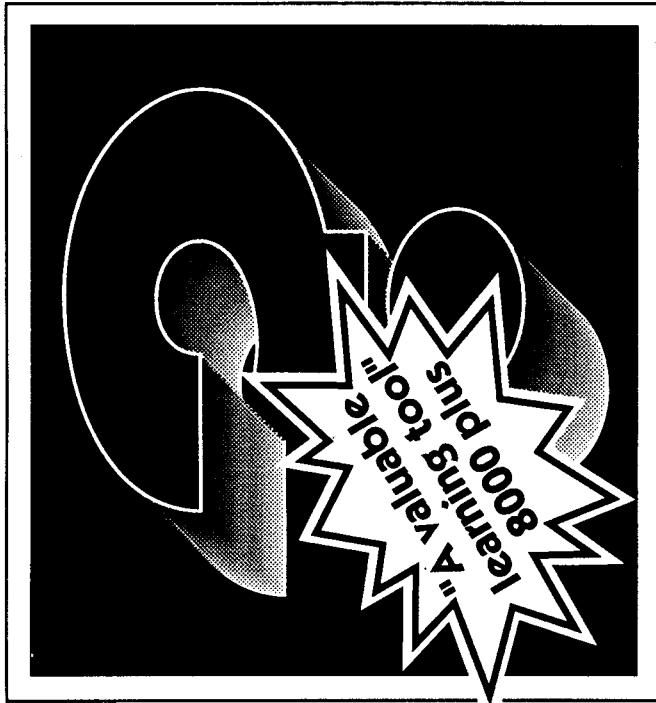

GETTING STARTED. The user manual for this program is supplied on disc. To use the manual program load CP/M. (switch on your PCW, and insert your CP/M system disc). At the CP/M A> prompt insert the ULTIMATE QUIZ disc and type the following command; README and press the RETURN key. User information for the README program will be displayed on screen.

The 9512 can read a 180k disc but cannot write to a 180k disc. If you have been supplied with a 180k disc, you must copy the supplied programs and question files on to one of your own formatted discs. Use Diskit or Locoscript to format a disc and copy the supplied disc using 800COPY.COM. Please see your PCW user manual for details of how to use this program. PLEASE NOTE. The copy disc options of DISCHIT and LOCOSCRIP1 cannot copy a 180k format disc.

If you find this difficult, please return the supplied disc to DGC Software, at the address below and you will be supplied with a PCW9512 720k format disc.

If you have been supplied with a Amstrad PCW9512 720k format disc all files/programs are stored on side 'A'.

Do I need to make a backup copy of the disc ?
YES always - accidents do happen. DGC Software programs are not copy protected. This is so you can make back-up copies, we hope you will not abuse this. When you have made a back-up copy, put the master disc in a safe place. If the worst should ever happen return your damaged master disc to DGC Software for replacement. The current disc replacement charge is £5.00

Getting started

Turn on your PCW and insert your CP/M system disc in 'A' drive. Once CP/M has loaded remove the CP/M system disc. Insert side 'A' of the ULTIMATE QUIZ program disc in 'A' drive.

Detailed program user instructions are provided in the README program. To operate this program, insert the ULTIMATE QUIZ disc and enter the following command:

README and press the RETURN key.

The README program will display the contents page. The program commands are displayed at the top of the screen. For example pressing the N key will display the next page. The user instructions can be printed by pressing the P key.

Providing user instructions on disc, allows us to keep the user instructions in line with program development.

The ULTIMATE QUIZ disc contains four major programs, each program is run by typing the program name at the CP/M system prompt, for example if you would like to use the QUIZ program type QUIZ and press the RETURN key. The other programs are EDIT, TEST, and QUIZPRINT.

Each program will ask for the name of the question file you wish to use. If the question file you wish to use is on another disc remove the program disc and insert the question file disc.

Enter the question file name of your choice eg. **GENERAL.QUIZ** and press the RETURN key. If the question file is not on the default drive prefix the file name with the drive. For example, if the default drive is A drive and the question file **GENERAL.QUIZ** was on the M drive, enter the file name as **M:GENERAL.QUIZ** Don't forget that more question files have been stored on side 'B' of the 180k master disc.

If the program reports that it cannot find the question data file, check your spelling and try again. If the program cannot find your file again press the STOP key and check the disc directory.

Some questions answered

How do I load CP/M ?

CP/M is on side two (or disc two) of the master discs supplied with your PCW.

To load CP/M - turn on your PCW and insert the CP/M disc.

If you see the Locoscript disc manager try again. If the computer beeps you have not inserted the CP/M system disc, insert the CP/M system disc and press the space bar.

What is the CP/M system prompt ?

When CP/M has loaded, you will see **A>**. This means that the computer is waiting for a command. The letter indicates which drive is the default drive.

What is the default drive ?

The default drive is the drive the computer will use to load a file from or save a file to unless told to use a different drive.

How do I change the default drive ?

If you wish to change the default drive to M drive, at the system prompt type **M:** and press the ENTER key. The system prompt will change to **M>**.

How do I know what files are on the disc ?

The CP/M directory command is **DIR**. At the system prompt type **DIR** and press ENTER. The computer will list all the files on the default drive. If you type **DIR M:** and press the ENTER key, the computer will list all the files found on the M drive.

How do I run a CP/M program ?

Insert the program disc and press the STOP key. Pressing the STOP key tells CP/M that you have changed discs. Use the **DIR** command to check the program name. All CP/M programs have the file extension **COM**, for example **QUIZ.COM**. Type the program name and press the ENTER key. If the program name is repeated with a question mark, CP/M cannot find the program, check your spelling. Do not type any spaces in the program name.
